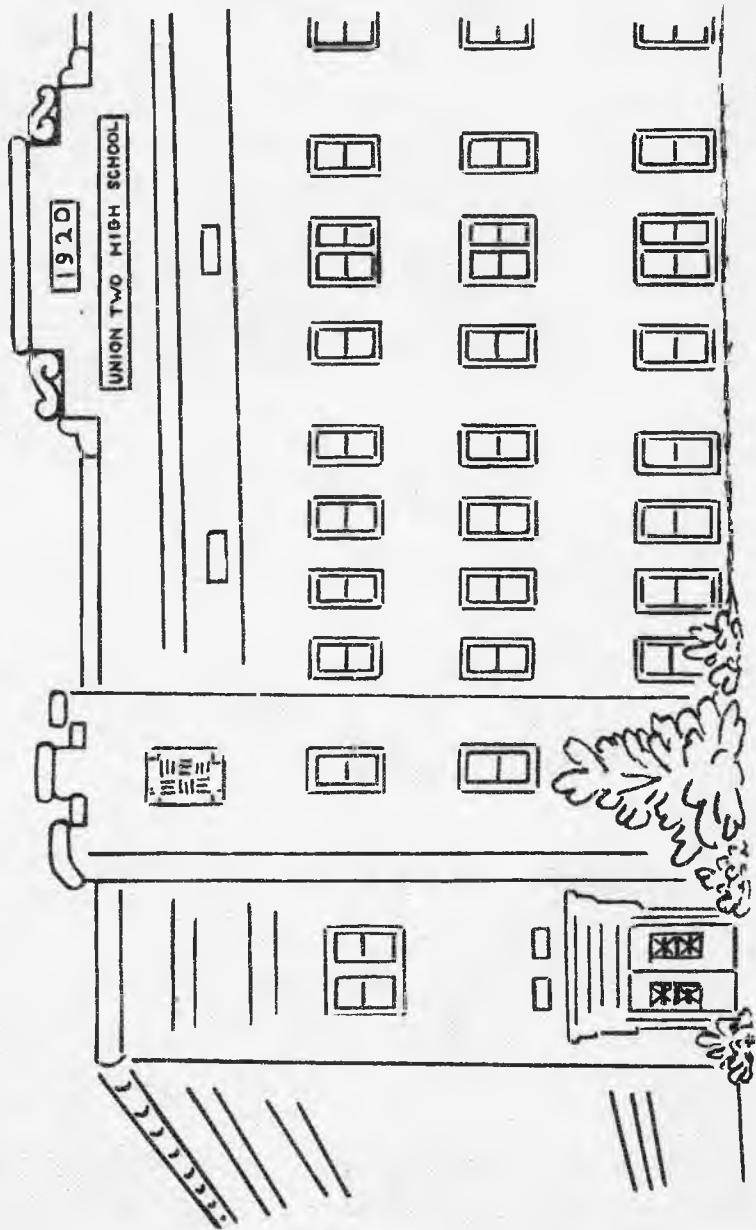

At press time the Culver Indians have a respectable record of seven victories and eight losses. Of these eight losses only three of them were by ten or more points. The Indians finally got on the victory trail by defeating North Judson 71-52. The inexperienced Bluejays just couldn't get started as Coach Crosley let his reserves play at

least two quarters each. Bruce led all scorers with 18 markers as Andy added 13.

The next weekend the Indians eeked past highly touted Caston 69-67. One man almost beat us but the tribe came on in the second half to defeat the Comets. The Indians were led by Lindvall's 24 and Lowry's 18 points.
